### **AACN - American Association of Critical Care Nurses**

#### **ECCO 2.0: Essentials of Critical Care Orientation**

An exciting web based program that offers 69 contact hours of critical care nursing education. There are 11 modules that are well organized around Anatomy and Physiology, assessment and diagnostic tools, and patient management principles backed by evidence - based practices.

#### **Basic ECG Interpretation:**

### **ENA - Emergency Nurses Association**

#### **ENPC: Emergency Nursing Pediatric Course**

#### **TNCC: Trauma Nursing Core Course**
