SJRMCM is a Catholic sponsored 145 bed full service acute care hospital, with an additional 16 skilled nursing beds in our Transitional Care Unit.

The SJRMCM Medical/Dental Staff is the largest staff for 100 miles and has 150 physicians and dentists covering 34 specialties.

SJRMCM is the Regional Referral Center for nine counties including; Clearwater, Idaho, Latah, Lewis and Nez Perc in Idaho; Asotin, Garfield, Whitman in Washington; and Wallowa in Oregon. SJRMCM has a nine bed Intensive/Cardiac Care Unit, an 11 bed Progressive Care Unit and dedicated nursing units for Medical Oncology, Surgical, Obstetrics, Pediatric and Mental Health patients.

There is a full array of diagnostic services including two MRI's, a 64 slice CT and an accredited Sleep Center. Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapies are available for patients and for outpatient follow-up. Hospice services are available for patients and families. The Emergency/Minor Care Departments see in excess of 28,000 visits annually.

Designated by the State of Washington as a Trauma Center, SJRMCM is firmly committed to assuring the availability of life saving trauma services for the region. This commitment includes: active involvement of the Medical Staff, maintaining personnel with trauma experience, state-of-the-art equipment for diagnosis and treatment, and a collaborative working arrangement with pre-hospital personnel. Through this active participation, St. Joseph Regional Medical Center continues the philosophy and mission of "People committed to life."

St. Joseph Regional Medical Center (SJRCM) offers an Orthopaedic Hospitalist Program.

Qualified orthopaedic surgeons provide 24 hours a day, seven days a week orthopaedic services at SJRCM. Orthopaedic Hospitalists respond to patients in the Emergency and Minor Care departments who have orthopaedic needs and assist in their assessment and treatment. If surgical procedures are needed, the Orthopaedic Hospitalist provide services in a timely manner and subsequently manage the patient in the inpatient or outpatient areas as indicated by the patient's condition.

What is an Orthopaedic Hospitalist?

Orthopaedic Hospitalists are orthopaedic surgeons who are trained in caring for patients with injuries of the musculoskeletal system, with extensive expertise in managing musculoskeletal trauma. Orthopaedic Hospitalist are dedicated to respond to Emergency Department and Minor Care patients ensuring promptness of treatment.

Why does SJRCM have Orthopaedic Hospitalist?

Having an Orthopaedic Hospitalist Program provides a positive impact on the timeliness and access to orthopaedic care through the Emergency and Minor Care Departments. This means quicker assessment and treatment that will enhance the patients experience when receiving care at the Medical Center.

When does the Orthopaedic Hospitalist see patients?

There is an Orthopaedic Hospitalist available at SJRCM around the clock - 24 hours a day, seven days a week - to meet patient needs.

What type of insurance do I need?

Consistent with SJRCM's Philosophy & Mission, the Orthopaedic Hospitalist program sees ALL patients that present to SJRCM's Emergency or Minor Care Departments regardless of insurance.



Who are the Orthopaedic Hospitalists?

SJRCM Orthopaedic Hospitalist physicians, do not have private practices, and treat only patients who are referred to the service through an emergency setting. Each Orthopaedic Hospitalist is Board Certified/Eligible in Orthopaedic Surgery.

How do I go about seeing the Orthopaedic Hospitalist for a follow-up?

Information regarding follow-up is included in discharge instructions. Patients need to contact St. Joseph Orthopaedic Care to schedule an appointment; the phone number is 208-750-7470.

St. Joseph Orthopaedic Hospitalist program offers an outpatient orthopedic follow-up clinic at the Lewiston Medical Center building located on the Medical Center campus. Follow-up services offered at the center provide a continuum of care for patients who have been treated by the Orthopaedic Hospitalist either in the Emergency Room, Minor Care or as an inpatient at SJRCM.
